It is through the apostolic Tradition preserved in the Church with the assistance of the Holy Spirit that we enjoy a living contact with the foundational memory. In this way the Church, in her doctrine, life and worship, perpetuates and transmits to every generation all that she herself is, all that she believes”.

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
Hb 1:2-3, 2:2-4; Ps 95; 2 Tm 1:6-8, 13-14; Lk 17:5-10

All the texts of this Sunday's Liturgy speak to us of faith, which is the foundation of the whole of Christian life. Jesus taught his disciples to grow in faith, to believe and to entrust themselves increasingly to him, in order to build their own lives on the rock. For this reason they asked him “increase our faith!” (Lk 17: 5). What they asked the Lord for is beautiful, it is the fundamental request: disciples do not ask for material gifts, they do not ask for privileges but for the grace of faith, which guides and illumines the whole of life; they ask for the grace to recognize God and to be in a close relationship with him, receiving from him all his gifts, even those of courage, love and hope.

The second part of today's Gospel presents another teaching, a teaching of humility that is nevertheless closely linked to faith. Jesus invites us to be humble and suggests the example of a servant who has worked in the fields. When he returns home, the master asks him to go on working. According to the mentality of Jesus' time the master had every right to do this. The servant owed his master total availability; and the master did not feel under any obligation to him for having carried out the orders he had received. Jesus makes us aware that, before God, we are in a similar situation: we are God's servants, we are not his creditors but are always indebted to him, because we owe him everything since everything is a gift from him. Accepting and doing his will is the approach to have every day, at every moment of our life. Before God we must never present ourselves as if we believe we have done a service and deserve a great reward. This is an illusion that can be born in everyone, even in people who work very hard in the Lord's service, in the Church. Rather, we must be aware that in reality we never do enough for God. We must say, as Jesus' suggests: “we are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty” (Lk 17: 10). This is an attitude of humility that really puts us in our place and permits the Lord to be very generous to us. In fact, in another Gospel passage, he promises people that “he will gird himself and have them sit at table, and he will come and serve them” (cf. Lk 12: 37). Dear friends, if we do God's will today with humility, without claiming anything from him, it will be Jesus himself who serves us, who helps us, who encourages us, who gives us strength and serenity.

RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY

As adopted daughters and sons of God, each October we begin the activities of Respect Life Month with the observance of Respect Life Sunday, celebrated on October 6th this year. As chair of the bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities, it is my pleasure to introduce this year's theme, which echoes Pope Francis' call for all people to “**Open your hearts to life!**”

What does it mean to open our hearts to life? It means to search our souls and acknowledge our deepest longing for Christ's love. Though we are capable of sins against human life such as abortion, assisted suicide and euthanasia, we are not beyond Christ's mercy. It is important for us to know and share with others that Christ's forgiveness is offered even to those who have taken another person's life, if they are truly repentant of that act.

We must respond to Pope Francis' call with great urgency. Opening our hearts to life in Christ empowers us for loving, merciful action toward others. We must give witness to the Gospel of Life and evangelize through our lives. We must personally engage others and share the truth about human life. We must continue to show love and mercy, especially with those who have been involved in abortion. All members of the Church can bring healing to the world by upholding the beauty of human life and God's unfailing mercy.

Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Hab 1:2-3, 2:2-4; Sal 95; 2 Tm 1:6-8, 13-14; Lc 17:5-10

Todos los textos de la liturgia de este domingo nos hablan de la fe, que es el fundamento de toda la vida cristiana. Jesús educó a sus discípulos a crecer en la fe, a creer y a confiar cada vez más en él, para construir su propia vida sobre roca. Por esto le piden: “Auméntanos la fe” (Lc 17, 6). Es una bella petición que dirigen al Señor, es la petición fundamental: los discípulos no piden bienes materiales, no piden privilegios; piden la gracia de la fe, que oriente e ilumine toda la vida; piden la gracia de reconocer a Dios y poder estar en relación íntima con él, recibiendo de él todos sus dones, incluso los de la valentía, el amor y la esperanza.

La segunda parte del Evangelio de hoy presenta otra enseñanza, una enseñanza de humildad, pero que está estrechamente ligada a la fe. Jesús nos invita a ser humildes y pone el ejemplo de un siervo que ha trabajado en el campo. Cuando regresa a casa, el patrón le pide que trabaje más. Según la mentalidad del tiempo de Jesús, el patrón tenía pleno derecho a hacerlo. El siervo debía al patrón una disponibilidad completa, y el patrón no se sentía obligado hacia él por haber cumplido las órdenes recibidas. Jesús nos hace tomar conciencia de que, frente a Dios, nos encontramos en una situación semejante: somos siervos de Dios; no somos acreedores frente a él, sino que somos siempre deudores, porque a él le debemos todo, porque todo es un don suyo. Aceptar y hacer su voluntad es la actitud que debemos tener cada día, en cada momento de nuestra vida. Ante Dios no debemos presentarnos nunca como quien cree haber prestado un servicio y por ello merece una gran recompensa. Esta es una falsa concepción que puede nacer en todos, incluso en las personas que trabajan mucho al servicio del Señor, en la Iglesia. En cambio, debemos ser conscientes de que, en realidad, no hacemos nunca bastante por Dios. Debemos decir, como nos sugiere Jesús: “Somos siervos inútiles, hemos hecho lo que teníamos que hacer” (Lc 17, 10). Esta es una actitud de humildad que nos pone verdaderamente en nuestro sitio y permite al Señor ser muy generoso con nosotros. En efecto, en otra parte del Evangelio nos promete que “se ceñirá, nos pondrá a su mesa y nos servirá” (cf. Lc 12, 37). Queridos amigos, si hacemos cada día la voluntad de Dios, con humildad, sin pretender nada de él, será Jesús mismo quien nos sirva, quien nos ayude, quien nos anime, quien nos dé fuerza y serenidad.

Cada octubre, como hijos e hijas adoptivos de Dios, comenzamos las actividades del Mes Respetemos la Vida celebrando el Domingo Respetemos la Vida, que este año cae el 6 de octubre. Debemos responder al llamado del Papa Francisco con la mayor urgencia. Abrir el corazón a la vida en Cristo nos permite tratar con bondad y misericordia a los demás. Debemos dar testimonio del Evangelio de la Vida y evangelizar con nuestras vidas. Debemos invitar a los demás a hacerlo y compartir la verdad sobre la vida humana. Debemos seguir demostrando amor y misericordia, en especial a quienes han participado en un aborto. Todos los miembros de la Iglesia pueden curar al mundo si defienden la belleza de la vida humana y de la misericordia infinita de Dios.
